Red Gold potatoes

Yellow squash and zucchini

Red and white onions

Green and purple peppers

Sweet red pepper

Yellow chard

Mixed greens

Head lettuce

Parsley

The long red pepper is actually a sweet pepper, not a hot pepper. It is the ripe version of the long green pepper you received a couple of weeks ago. All colored peppers start out green (or purple!), and as they ripen turn red, yellow, orange or dark red. When they turn color, they also turn sweet.
